

### The Problem

Anyone that has completed a non-trivial project will know the importance of team work in delivering a project. Good communication between the Sponsor, Project Manager, project team members and other stakeholders is critical to successful teamwork. Meetings, progress reports and conference calls are all used to 'push' communication to users; in the 'information overload' age, successful teams need to allow stakeholders to 'pull' information.

The wide availability of Microsoft Outlook means it's well suited as a repository for project information which stakeholders can access as they need ('pull'). The challenge is getting information into Microsoft Outlook from Microsoft Project without a web-client, complex export steps or a Project Server.

## The Solution

Project 2 Outlook is an add-in to Microsoft Project 2010/2013 that exports project tasks to a user selected Microsoft Outlook Calendar or Task Folder.

Exported tasks appear in Microsoft Outlook as either

Tasks or Appointments; stakeholders can view project
appointments next to personal and business activities.

This tool saves the time spent on complex export and
formatting processes. Project Managers can focus on
more valuable tasks related to managing delivery.
